VALIDITY /PROCEDURE:

- The Protest was valid and the hearing continued.

FACTS FOUND:

1. Sea conditions: approx. 10 – 12 knots of wind.
2. Approaching Flax Point, Mojo, Carerra and Georgia One were on port, with Carerra to leeward of Mojo, and Georgia about 1 ½ boatlengths astern of both.
3. Mojo and Carerra gybed onto starboard outside the zone.
4. At the zone, Georgia One was inside overlapped on port.
5. Mojo altered course and gave Georgia One mark room.

CONCLUSION and RULES that Apply

- Georgia was inside overlapped at the zone, and entitled to mark room.
- Mojo gave mark room as required by RRS18.2(b)
